Directions to garden:

40 miles East of Spokane, WA on highway 2. Turn left at Golden Spur Motel. Drive to 4-way stop. Turn left. Drive 2 blocks to Craig Avenue. Turn right. We are the whole 200 block of Craig Avenue. Park near the iris flag. You will also see Alpacas and sheep in the pasture. We are not wheelchair accessible in the rows but have level ground around the various fields. Wear walking shoes.
